Combined with the easy social aspects that make it fun to find other streams, watch, and perhaps more importantly, share your own streams with friends and upload them to YouTube to preserve content after the stream has ended, this is a long way from some of the older live streaming apps that have been around and wanted to be YouTube competitors rather than live next to it. This is for periscope's greatest feature – the fact that it's deadly easy to start a stream, share a stream, and interact with viewers. From installation to stream, it's just a few steps, and from there, starting the stream is pretty much a tap case. Share it on Twitter and watch people tune in, leave messages in real time, shower your heart, and there's a tool people actually use to share interesting moments in their lives or newsworthy as well. It is that ease of use and simplicity that has made Periscope the tool of choice for those who want to do awesome things like share their kids games with family members who live around the world or protesters who want to stream a march through an enthusiastic and dedicated community on social media or live on television. At the same time, it's just as easy to use, making it easier to stream and record, such as the latest episode of Game of Thrones or a paid boxing match. That said, I've seen them use our colleagues at Kotaku to cover E3 on the show floor, and some of my favorite YouTubers do live unboxings for fans instead of having them wait for an official video-both use the service. Periscopic says it wants to help see the world through someone else's eyes, and it certainly succeeds. Perhaps most of all, however, that stands out gives us a social tool that brings us all a little closer and and super easy to use at the same time. Where it falls ShortPeriscope is simple and elegant, but it is not completely perfect. The integration with Twitter is tight (which makes sense), but it could be integrated better with other networks as well, and saving videos and uploading them to YouTube later is great, but other video services would be a nice perk as well. Granted, all this is not game breaking and adding a lot of bells and whistles can change the balance of simplicity-to-features that Periscope goes for it in droves. We would have complained recently that Periscope only has a portrait because it knows how we all feel about portrait videos, but that's no longer a problem, as the latest update allows for landscape photography. In its current form, we've seen multiple streams with patchy connections and stuttering streams, but it's always hard to tell if that's the app, the user's connection, the user's device or the viewer's connection. It's also worth noting that Periscope is Android 4.4 and later, so if you're still running an older version of Android or an older device, you're out of luck. CompetitionMeerkat (Free) is Periscope's biggest tournament and, to be fair, it came first. While the two used to be fierce competitors, they're a little different now. Meerkat only broadcasts public, live events, much harder than Periscope. The user interface is a little more cluttered and certainly less elegant and a little trickier to use. Starting with the stream is a one-touch affair, but it kind of comes as a surprise and there's virtually no setup. However, registering is a little easier (you only have your phone number, a profile photo and a username all you need) and you don't have to link your Twitter account until you want to, you can link the app to Facebook even if you want. In any case, it's a good option if you've been using it or if you know people are using it, but we definitely prefer Periscope. Livestream (Free) is one of the old guard of live streaming apps. Livestream is a web service that has been around for years, and mobile apps have always made live events streaming from your phone, whether it's using the camera or how big your community is, relatively simple. The app has come a long way in the days after Meerkat and after Perisco, and is now much easier to use. Partnerships with TV networks and sports leagues also mean that events streamed over the Internet through Livestream are events you can watch on your phone and replay events after it's over, save your own streams to share elsewhere, connect with Facebook, Twitter or Instagram, and connect with other streamers. Again, it's not as simple or simple as some of the other here, but useful if you're looking for an alternative or more live events to watch. UStream (free) is From the old guard, but it's tough to recommend. HD streaming is only available on certain devices, not even certain versions of Android, and the focus is straight out UStream.com, not necessarily when streaming from your device. You can stream from your device, this is obviously not what the app is actually designed for. If you have a favorite stream of Ustream though (like this live HD view from the International Space Station) and want to check out your phone or tablet, or if you're streaming and want to see how you look on another device, then you might want to check it out. YouNow (Free) is a little less focused on the whole stream of events and to see through someone else's perspective angle and aim more at people who want to stream myself with my friends and chat with them if it makes sense. Where Periscope and Meerkat feel a little more mature, YouNow uses a significant portion of the screen for live chat and recommended broadcasts, depending on whether you're the one streaming or watching (respectively.) To keep users engaged, the service has a point and in-app currency system that gives you points for certain activities that you can then use up the level and buy in-app coins and bars, some of which cost real money. YouNow seems to be fun as a community if it's the kind of environment you're in (and make money to toss into it), but the reviews on Google Play aren't as encouraging as the functionality of the app is concerned. They're the big players. There are a few others like TwitCasting Live (Free) and Stre.am (Free), both promising feature-wise and seem to work pretty well, but both smaller players have smaller communities and userbases. That's not to say you don't look at them, but it does mean that if you're looking for a community or people to sign up and watch the stream or interact with you, it might be better to do something a little bigger. TwitCasting walks the line between Periscope and Hangouts, which allows you to invite other people to the stream, but the UI is a super crowded and tries a little too hard to focus on chat. Stre.am, on the other hand, it's light and elegant, just empty.
